## PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCES DEVELOPMENT OF THE STUDENTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION

Interdisciplinary integration, presented in a form that enhances the educational space, creates a kind of multi-disciplinary virtual learning laboratory in which a student repeatedly applying the knowledge in each discipline in the new environment, outside the discipline, and develops the ability to apply knowledge in professional work.
